

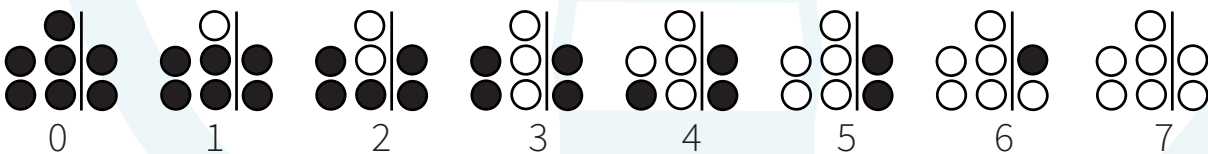
NATEY

The Natey has the same pentatonic scale and fingering as the Native American Flute (NAF). Because a vesselflute sounds a whole octave lower than an open flute you'll get the same pitch on a much smaller, portable instrument. You can even use the smaller ones like a necklace! The Natey has two extra thumbholes to simulate the over-tones that can be played on some NAF's.

All of my instruments are made by hand and with love and patience.
A few tips to get you going:

- ▶ Blow every note with a "Tuu", this will give you the best sound.
- ▶ The higher notes need a little more air, this is common with an closed vesselflute.
- ▶ Support your instrument always with your little fingers, like that they never can fall down.
